- (Genesis 1:11-12) And ELOHIM (H430) [God] AMAR (H559) [said], Let the ERETS (H776) [earth] **DASHA (H1876) [bring forth] DESHE (H1877) [grass]**, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, ASHER (H834) [whose] seed is in itself, AL (H5921) [upon] the ERETS (H776) [earth]: and it HAYAH (H1961) [was] KEN (H3651) [so]. And the ERETS (H776) [earth] brought forth **DESHE (H1877) [grass]**, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, ASHER (H834) [whose] seed was in itself, after his kind: and ELOHIM (H430) [Go/d] RA'AH (H7200) [saw] KIY (H3588) [that] it was TOB (H2896) [good].
